- 🖱️ Finding & taking online courses

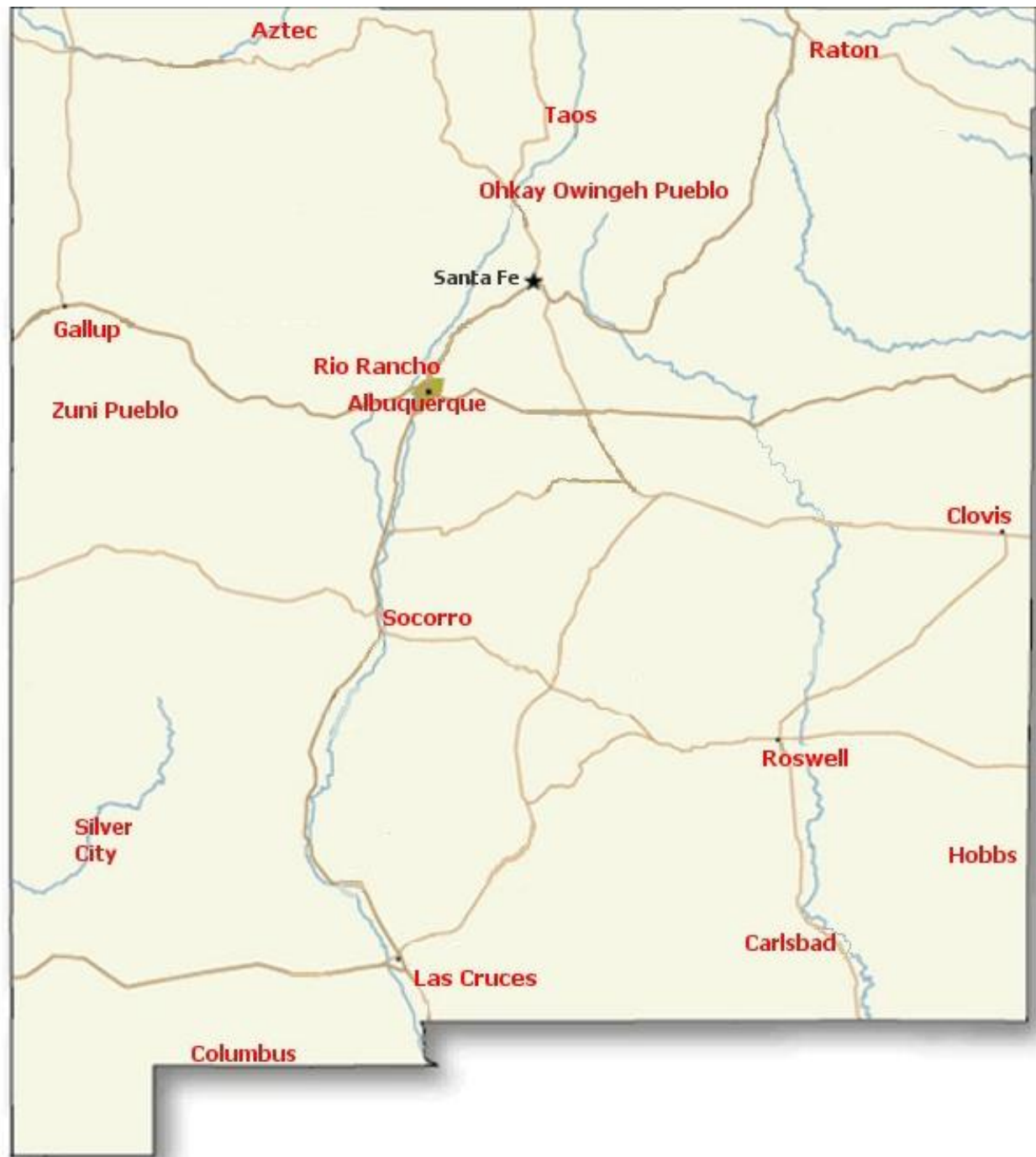
