
Panels can be opened or closed by clicking on the panel name at the top of the column, or by using the X in the individual panel.







KEYSPOTS are locations for Internet access, technology and training opportunities across Philadelphia.

Each location creates a space for self-defined success – whether it's completing school work, searching for jobs, researching colleges, or accessing health information.


