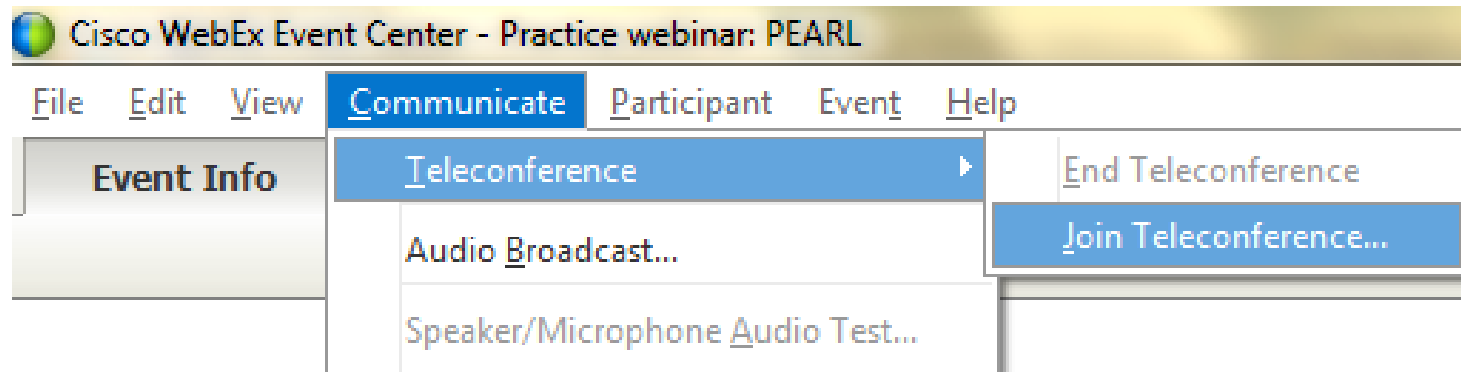

Stretching Your Program Funding

Many of CPL's programs are made possible by our generous Friends of the Library. Even so, we want to make those funds work as effectively for us as they can. Most of the program supplies used are already on hand. But the special items – such as books for each child in our Migrant Ed Program, are extra. 14. This wonderful tool is FREE and available 24/7 to all Seward Memorial Library patrons, thanks to funding from the Friends of Seward Library.

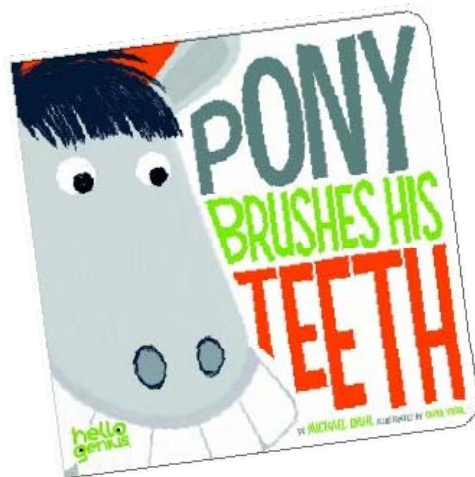
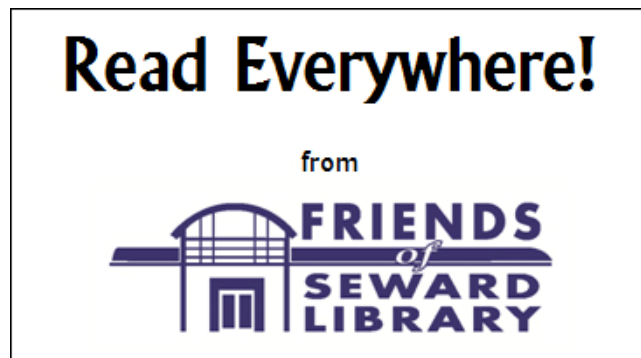
