Steps to Success: Computer Class and Resource Referral List

Even the most vigorous training program can't serve every digital literacy need. Here you'll compose a list of community organizations that offer technology services and resources to easily refer community members in the event additional services are needed. Begin with the resources you uncovered in the "Getting to Know Your Library: the Community" worksheet and dive deeper. Include free, low cost (>\$100), and high cost options. Examples of places to include on your training list are churches, community centers, community colleges, and job placement centers. Examples of resources to targeted populations include classes in a specific language such as Spanish, devices for the blind or physically handicapped, or programs with certain income restrictions.
