Record Setting Support! - Jennifer Pharr Davis - Orca 1 & 2

In 2011, Jennifer Pharr Davis set the endurance record on the Appalachian Trail. She hiked 47 miles a day for 46 straight days, but she didn't do it alone. Jen had a dedicated support team with over 30 individuals and 75,000 miles of trail experience helping her down the trail. Working as a team in high-stress environments requires clear communication, resolve, and the ability to focus on the future rather than dwell on the past.
