



- Not during season: football/theatre
- Enough time to publicize

- No Money-No Problem-Partnerships
- Grant \$
- Humanities Councils/Arts Councils

Program Plan

Questions to Answer

- What type of program you want to offer?
- Specific topic: What's popular or "hot" right now in your community or elsewhere?
- Format: Hands on class, demo, seminar
- What library goal does this satisfy?
- Who is your audience?

- What space is available?
- Date & Time?
- Budget
- Registration or fee
- Partnerships
- Marketing budget/avenues/timeline

Program Plan Example

- Essential Oils-Everyday Use & Cooking
- Demonstration
- Public Education goal on the strategic plan
- Adults/General Public
- Library Kitchen
- Evening/Samples provided/ 6:00 pm
- \$50-\$100=supplies \$250 advertising
- No registration and no fee








 Fire & Rescue, social services


Program Ideas

South Dakota Humanities Speakers Bureau Libraries pay a \$50 grant application fee; SD Humanities pay presenters & their expenses.





Attendance

35 adults 8 elementary aged children

20 people first time to attend a program at the public library

Cost \$

- Free Press release to newspaper & radio
- Free Social Media
- Created posters in house. \$25 printing
- Gardeners brought their supplies. Gave away seed plantings for door prizes.

Survey Questions

Demographics

- Age: 18-24, 25-39, 40-55, 56-70+
- City residents, county
- Do you have a library card?

Previous Experience

- Is this your first time visiting our library?
- Have you attended a program before? If so, which one?
- Are you interested in providing a program/demo for the library?

About the Program

- Was the topic/program interesting or entertaining?
- Did it start and end promptly
- Was it "as advertised?"
- What other topics would you attend?

Wrap Up Notes & Survey

- Strike while you have them onsite
- Take a quick verbal survey
- Have paper surveys available when they leave
- Make your notes before you leave the building
- Refresh and add to your notes the next day
