

## Begin by letting go





### "Zoom fatigue" is real

- Excessive amounts of close-up eye contact is highly intense.
- Seeing yourself during video chats constantly in real-time is fatiguing.
- 3) Video chats dramatically reduce our usual mobility.
- 4) The cognitive load is much higher in video chats.



- Pen to paper reflections


### Background visuals - video














- Use participant video to connect, even just for greetings.

- Tailor to your session audience and goals






