

What does an authentic relationship look like?

- Start with respect.
- Engagement, not outreach. Listen instead of promoting learn about strengths, gifts, and aspirations.
- Transformational, not transactional. It's about people and process, not product.
- Commit to sustaining the relationship.

Asking and listening are more powerful than telling.




Everyone has agency and shares ownership. No giver/taker divide.




Relational Ways of Knowing








