Career Centers

- Classes offer introduction to common programs like Word and Excel.
- Classes are also available for basic internet searching skills.
- Assistance with student loans.
- Staff offers these classes twice every week.



Learn-A-Test

- Allows all Mississippians access to hundreds of standard tests.
- 32% of young adults (16-18) are unemployed.
- Both employed and unemployed citizens can prepare for civil service, real estate, or college preparation exams.

What is E-WIN?

- Job Seekers: Information on job search training, resume writing, and job fairs.
- Employers: Information on employee training, filing taxes, and wage information.
- Unemployed: Information on available benefits and claim filing.
