Name Change

How to stop child support from being withheld from your paycheck because child support is no longer required in your case.

4. Paternity Kit

How to establish a legal relationship between a parent and child.

AFFIDAVITS

1. Affidavit of Inability to Pay

A sworn statement that you cannot afford to pay the court's filing fee.

2. General Affidavit

A sworn written statement, signed in front of a notary public.

COURT PROCEDURE

Giving Notice

1. Legal Notice

How to give the other party legal notice that you filed a case in court (also called Service of Citation or Service of Process).

2. Substitute Service

How to ask the court to allow alternate methods of service when attempts to serve the respondent have failed.

3. Service by Posting

How to serve your spouse with legal notice of divorce when you cannot locate him/her and have no children together.

4. Service by Publication

How to serve your spouse in a family law matter when you cannot locate him/her and you have children together.

5. Serving the Document and Certificate of Service

How to give copies of documents filed in your case to the other party as required by the rules of civil procedure.

6. Original Answer

How to file an Answer when the respondent does not want to waive his/her rights in the case.

7. DWOP

How to reinstate your case if it is "Dismissed for Want of Prosecution" (DWOP).

Judgments

8. Default Judgment Kit

How to finalize a case in court when the respondent in the case did not respond or appear in court.

9. Nunc Pro Tunc

How to correct a clerical mistake in a judgment.

OTHER FORMS
